**Narrative:** Officer Dave Alcox was killed in the line of duty January 15, 1980 while serving as an Oak Hill Police Officer. Dave was a 1972 Oak Hill High School graduate and at the time of his untimely death Dave was attending Rio Grande College to become a teacher.

In an effort to never forget Dave's sacrifice for the Village, the Oak Hill Officers and Families established the Officer Dave Alcox Memorial Scholarship so that in Dave's memory another Oak Hill student could realize their dreams and attend college.
